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INTRODUCTION

This prayer concordance is much more than just a book to “decree and declare” your faith. It is a guide to His heart. In every scripture listed, there is an aspect of His Perfect Love that is revealed. By reminding ourselves of who He is and just how much He wants us whole and free, our faith will become steadfast and our confidence in His perfect plans for us will be unwavering. Even when feeling desperate for help, it’s in touching His heart that we will be changed from the inside out. It’s there that we will find the courage, strength, and faith to override and overcome spirits of infirmity and become whole.

In using this prayer concordance, my prayer is that you will meet HIM. The written prayers are merely meant to be “jump starters” and not just liturgical readings. Feel free to paraphrase them as the Spirit directs you to pray. This is your prayer journal, not mine. I’m just giving you a head start in building your own style of communication with the Lord.

I have written all the prayers in first person, but they can certainly be changed to third person when needed. The goal is to establish a heart connection before anything else. We don’t have to command or demand His will to be done. He longs to answer our prayers simply because we are His sons and daughters. Whatever healing you need, whether it’s physical, emotional or spiritual – He’s the answer. He is your Healer. Get to know Him and yield to His plans. Pursue His presence and lean into His heart. You may be surprised at what He shows you.

Though I personally use the English Standard Version as my choice for study, I chose the New International Version as the primary source for the scripture references, simply because it is the most common.

MY OWN STORY OF PURSUIT

My husband, Bobby, and I have always enjoyed good health with very few visits to a doctor over the past 35 years. We have always led a relatively healthy lifestyle with very few issues that would indicate any troubling medical condition. But that all changed in 2023. Starting with a debilitating attack of Tinnitus in March of that year, I went through months of agonizing torment, pain, and sleepless nights as we contended for breakthrough. The ringing in my left ear was so loud I had to sleep in a separate room from my husband with both a sound machine and worship music loud enough to drown out the ring. For the first time that we could remember, our decrees and declarations of faith seemed to make little difference in the battle. Even as we rebuked the enemy, prayed in tongues, and did everything we knew, the breakthrough didn't come like we expected. We quickly learned that we were being led on a journey requiring us to listen much more closely to the Lord's directives each and every day. Everything we had assumed about faith for healing was being severely tested. In the process, He was going to finetune our sensitivity to His voice and upgrade our understanding of getting healed.

Thankfully, within the first several weeks, the Lord exposed some tormenting spirits that had come to shut down my ability to hear from the Lord and distract me from my call as a prophet. Speaking on national platforms during this time, I had become a prime target of enemy forces. As we sought the Lord for direction, the Holy Spirit taught us how to stop the demonic attacks and nullify their effect. He told us that our relational covenant and oneness in prayer were going to be key factors in getting my breakthrough. As a result, I was not only delivered from these demonic intruders, but freed from a spirit of fear that had settled over me on the night of the initial attack.

Through the process, I even learned how to recognize the different sound of the tormenting spirits and not just the annoying ring of a physical condition. I still remember the night when I knew the last de-

monic spirit was gone. The bullhorn that had been sounding around a level 7 in my ear was finally cut in half, and there was no longer any torment or fear attached to it. Instead, a blanket of peace settled upon me, and I was able to function beyond just survival and even get some sleep. Even though I knew I still had further to go for my complete healing, I wasn't fighting demons anymore.

The Battle of the Mind

During this initial phase of my journey, the battle was not only with tormenting spirits but my own thoughts. It was just as much a battle of the mind as it was a battle of the spirit. Those tormenting demons had been shouting in my ear non-stop, and I had to learn how to ignore their temper tantrums and not give in to their influence. There were nights when I would plead with the Lord to just make them stop and His response was always the same: "My grace is greater, Wanda!" He wanted me to lean into Him and learn how to tune out the enemy's voice – no matter how loud it was. Little did I realize how much He was training me in the battle. He was helping me to find His grace and strength in the midst of the noise and fix my eyes and ears on Him. He wanted me to know just how big He was and how much stronger His presence and grace were in the middle of enemy warfare. He told me later that the only way I could overcome my fears was to face them. I learned that sometimes our freedom comes, not because the enemy leaves, but because we stand stronger. This was a core truth that would be tested many times in the days to come and marked much of my journey!

During the few weeks when we were battling these demonic spirits, the Lord taught us how to ask for His direction before every prayer. Instead of always assuming we needed to rebuke and renounce these tormenting spirits, sometimes He simply wanted us to worship. Other times He wanted us to be still and quiet, waiting in His presence. He had already shown us the power of praying in tongues before addressing any attack. Because we didn't always know what to do, we always started by worshipping Him and praying in the Spirit. It was then that He would show us what to do. At one point, He even said to just ignore them! He was teaching us to look to Him before trusting in our own understanding. It

was a constant reminder that this was a journey of knowing HIM more than just fixing the problem.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and do not lean on your own understanding. In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make straight your paths." (Proverbs 3:5-6 ESV)

Crazy Faith and a Controversial Protocol

Once I was finally free from the tormenting spirits, I could finally focus on the underlying physical root causes of the remaining ring. Even as we continued praying scriptures for healing and declaring God's goodness, I knew that some of my physical symptoms were caused by other factors. I knew that it wasn't just a matter of getting healed. It was a matter of being healthy. There's a big difference!

It was at this time that the Lord directed me to try a controversial protocol that carried some unknown risks. Dr. Bryan Ardiss was just beginning to share his breaking revelations about the use of nicotine in healing long-haul Covid symptoms. I had already been receiving messages and emails from followers who indicated they began to experience tinnitus when they got Covid, and more specifically, after receiving the shot. Though neither Bobby nor I had received the shot, we had both experienced the painful realities of Covid. We had also begun to hear about "shedding" and how non-vaccinated persons can experience the same negative effects of the shot just by being around those who were vaccinated. Thus, I was curious if my tinnitus might be the result of shedding.

Dr. Ardiss reported that nicotine isn't addictive (as we've been told) and that the use of nicotine gum or patches had already been tested and proven to eradicate the harmful side effects of Covid and the vaccine. Through several unexpected conversations (one indirectly with Dr. Ardiss), some prophetic dreams, and upon further research, we felt the Lord gave us the green light to try this unusual protocol. Ultimately, we knew that Jesus was the Healer and that He could use whatever He wanted if we surrendered it to Him (1 Timothy 4:4-5). So, we got some nicotine gum, sanctified it in prayer, and I started taking it.

I share these details because my entire healing journey was one of getting His instructions on a daily basis. It was clear from the beginning of this process that He had something very specific in mind to teach us. Knowing how the enemy was going to work, God had determined to use this battle as a means of us gathering strategic intel concerning the devil's schemes. In walking us through the valleys we would face, He was going to give us tools and insights that would help many others who would face similar challenges. But it would require us putting away any expectations or presumptions of how He was going to work, and pursuing Him on a daily basis for direction. One of the major lessons I learned through this whole process was the importance of obeying His voice, and as a minister who depends on hearing His voice clearly and accurately, I knew I wanted to pass this test!

The other factor that made this journey so significant was that several months prior to me being hit with tinnitus, Bobby had been diagnosed with glaucoma in his right eye. Being an extremely fit and healthy person his entire life, this was a surprise to us and we had already been seeking the Lord on his behalf. He was having increased vision problems, and though it didn't cause much pain, he found his energy being depleted and an increased lack of physical strength and stamina. Thus, for the first time in our marriage, we were both experiencing physical issues beyond the norm. I also began to realize that what we were experiencing was no "coincidence." A pastor's vision was being attacked and a prophet's hearing was being threatened. We knew that this was a battle of both body and spirit. So, we set ourselves to partner with the Holy Spirit in this walk of discovery and breakthrough.

As stated before, we knew that our faith was being upgraded and deepened in this journey. We had both already been operating in a gift of faith throughout our entire marriage, seeing God do miraculous things in our finances, family, and ministry. But now that we were both facing physical challenges, we needed to apply our faith to our healing.

Surprised by the Spirit

One of the most surprising lessons in this came after I took my first "dose" of the nicotine gum. What happened upon my simple act of faith will forever be imprinted in my soul and spirit. Five minutes after I started chewing the gum, the Holy Spirit came upon me so powerfully, I fell to the floor in my living room and was overcome by the joy of the Lord! I was totally shocked at this unexpected visitation. After weeks and months of wondering if He was really there in the midst of constant pain and discomfort, this sudden manifestation of His tangible presence totally caught me off guard.

But as I lay there feeling the heavy blanket of His presence, He told me, "I'm rewarding your faith, Wanda!" I immediately felt the joy of His heart in my radical decision to trust Him in doing something as crazy as chewing nicotine gum! I felt at that moment that He could have directed me to do any number of things, but the focus wasn't the "what" but the "Who." All He wanted was for me to listen to His voice, trust Him, and follow His lead. He was demonstrating His delight and pleasure in my childlike faith to trust Him in the midst of pain, discouragement, and a totally radical treatment idea. Not only did I feel His close presence hovering over me, I could also sense angels nearby who were laughing at the enemy, rejoicing in my victory, and cheering me on in my walk of faith.

As a result of my simple obedience I was overcome by His presence, reassured of His love, and strengthened in my faith. Just the night before, I had been awakened, yet again, by a spirit of fear. Sensing that Holy Spirit was about to do something powerful, the enemy was trying to harass me and immobilize my faith. I had awoken with great trepidation and apprehension in trying this whole nicotine idea. But by joining in agreement with Bobby the following morning and stepping out in faith, that spirit of fear was immediately dealt with, and the joy of the Lord flooded my soul.

*"And without faith it is impossible to please Him,
for whoever would draw near to God must believe that He exists and
that He rewards those who seek Him." (Hebrews 11:6)*

Seeming Contradictions

Interestingly, I was surprised to realize that the ring in my ear was still there. Even as I was experiencing the powerful presence of the Lord, my ear was still ringing! So, even as I took in this powerful encounter, I instinctively knew this journey was far from over. This was not the culmination of my faith, nor was this the key to my healing. And as amazing as this sudden visitation was, it wasn't the high point of my journey. It was only the beginning.

That first dose was just the start of ongoing visitations and encounters with the Lord. The nicotine protocol called for me to chew nicotine gum four times a day. I had only taken the first dose that morning and had three more to go. Upon taking the second dose a few hours later, I was stunned when the same thing happened. Five minutes after chewing the gum, the Holy Spirit came upon me again in the same measure and I had to sit down to take it all in. Lasting almost an hour, His overwhelming presence was just as strong and just as surprising.

This continued with the third and fourth dose that day - and continued the next day, and the next - after every dose. The tangible and powerful presence of the Lord descended upon me each and every time I took a dose of this strange protocol. What became rather humorous was that instead of becoming addicted to nicotine, I was becoming addicted to His presence! And that's exactly what He wanted. He was teaching me how to recognize His tangible presence and to set aside whatever I was doing and simply yield. Because His weight was so strong, I had already known to sit down whenever I took a dose so I wouldn't keel over somewhere and hurt myself. It was apparent that He was taking me much deeper than anticipated and giving me keys to healing that I'd never considered. The reality was, even if my body wasn't being physically healed yet in the way I expected, my soul and spirit were being radically healed and transformed. His presence became my medicine. Literally!

In each of these encounters, He revealed something different about His character. He would show me His love, His tenderness, His power, and many other aspects of His nature. One Sunday afternoon, I was

overwhelmed with His beauty. I had never felt impressed by this before, and my heart was overwhelmed when He poured over me a liquid love and revelation of how beautiful He was. I wept and rejoiced in this new revelation and actually told Him to stop as I didn't think my physical body could handle so much glory! The truth was - what had started as a nightmare a few months before was now turning into heavenly encounters I never could have imagined. I was finding HIM.

And yet, throughout the coming days of visitation - the ring continued. This divine contradiction forced me to learn things I didn't know I needed. Not only was I recognizing His presence and receiving increased wisdom and insight into heavenly realities, He was also strengthening my resolve and perseverance. He was building my character and putting something inside of me that I knew would be needed for future assignments and mandates.

"Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us." (Romans 5:3-5 ESV)

Throughout the days of visitation, I began to embrace the process instead of fighting it. I knew He was doing a sacred work and I couldn't rush the process. I also knew that the gift of resourcing that He had given me would be helpful for countless others who were struggling with physical attacks and chronic health issues.

Underlying Causes

As the Lord began to teach me about underlying root causes, He led me down a rabbit hole. I began to learn the truths about inflammation and the various toxins in our bodies that cause many of the symptoms both Bobby and I were experiencing. We learned how many of our food sources were laden with man-made products that were extremely unhealthy and damaging. Recognizing for the first time that my constant nasal congestion and seasonal stuffiness was not normal, and should be treated, I went off all gluten, dairy, seed oils, and processed foods. I had never considered

that inflammation in my sinuses could produce an irritating ring! I began to actually listen to my body and pay attention to what I was eating and how it affected me. The scripture about “rightly discerning the body” took on a whole new meaning for me (1 Corinthians 11:29)!

I also learned about many of the natural supplements and healing remedies that God had already put within nature to treat and cure our ailments. I started using castor oil packs to help loosen up and drain my lymphatic system and began to find relief. I could tell the difference when cutting out certain foods and taking the right vitamins. We were finally beginning to understand health from a wholistic perspective, not dependent on man-made drugs or manufactured medicines. We both went on a heavy-metal detox, and I did a parasite cleanse. We began to be more mindful about what vitamins and minerals we each needed and became intentional in formulating a plan for long-term health. As a result, little by little, the sound in my ear began to decrease even more. Bobby began to feel a return of energy as we began to exercise together, and we knew we were on the right track. As we heeded every directive the Lord gave us and prayed together consistently, we saw gradual improvement both physically and spiritually.

The Biggest Revelation

In the midst of all the revelation the Lord was giving about healing protocols, I was determined to make my faith in Him the priority. Even with all the practical wisdom He was giving us, we sensed it would still take some supernatural intervention to overcome some of the lingering issues we faced. I’ve always known the power of declaring His Word and wondered if I didn’t need to do more of this on a daily basis. One morning when I was thinking about this, the Lord interrupted my thought process to bring me the revelation I needed to hear:

“This is more about getting to know Me as your Healer than it is in getting your healing.”

The truth of His tender rebuke freed me from condemnation, but also challenged me. How much of my faith for healing was focused on getting

my breakthrough instead of getting to know Him as Healer? How much was I bypassing conversation with Him just to recite more scriptures or collect more information about my symptoms? It was a reminder that this wasn’t about seeking a word for healing, but seeking His heart. This is where our faith must rest. Not just in what He says – but in who He is. It’s our confidence in His unconditional love and care for us that will determine the true level of our faith. It’s our absolute belief in His goodness that must be the core of our faith. Even in the midst of contradictions and disappointments, we must believe that He is altogether good and wants us healed and set free.

Baptism by Fire

I was now six months into this journey, and I still had no idea where He was taking me. I had been doing the nicotine protocol for several weeks and was still reveling in His ongoing presence. I eventually realized that the remaining ring in my ear was not caused by anything related to Covid as the nicotine had little physical impact. Even so, it was clear that the Lord used the nicotine protocol as a touch point for my faith and a means to bring me into His presence on a consistent basis. Because of the research I had done, I was now able to suggest this possible remedy for others. Even though the nicotine didn’t make any visible difference, my physical symptoms were still slowly improving.

I continued to follow every directive the Lord gave me, and I was constantly reminded of His oversight in this journey. I continued to stand on His Word and yield to His presence. Still, I was desperate to be free of the (level 3) ring and had yet to experience the big breakthrough I was hoping for. And then, the Lord surprised me yet again.

One night around 3 a.m. I was stirred awake. I sensed Him kneeling down right beside me at my bed and He immediately whispered in my ear, “It’s Me. I’m here.” He wanted to assure me of this, because only a few moments later I began to feel my entire body on fire. It came on so suddenly I was initially frightened. It felt like I was being electrocuted. From the top of my head to the bottom of my toes, I felt my body react to something I’d never experienced before.

My first reaction was fear. I actually began to wonder if the nicotine was beginning to have a negative affect on my body and I woke up Bobby. He saw my distress and quickly assessed my condition to make sure I was OK. But even as he was asking me questions and checking my temperature, I suddenly remembered the words: “It’s Me. I’m here.” It was then that I realized I was not experiencing some negative physical reaction to the nicotine, but experiencing a powerful download of the supernatural kind.

“I baptize you with water for repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.” (Matthew 3:11 ESV)

I had heard others speak of a “baptism of fire,” but had no clue what that was or how it might feel. Yet, I knew that my body was on fire – and that it was totally of the Lord. Instead of feeling the usual warm blanket of His presence, or even the tingling and shaking of His Spirit that I had known many times before, this sensation was on another level. It felt like I was being “plugged in” to something and getting electrically charged! As I lay there, unable to move, I knew I could only yield. Whatever He was doing, I couldn’t escape it. Nor did I want to. It was terrifying – yet glorious. I knew I was touching something outside this realm, and it was touching me. There was no doubt whatsoever that I was being radically touched from above. The fire of the Lord continued to burn for over an hour and gradually subsided after two. Even as I woke up the next morning, I could still feel the lingering affects of the encounter.

“Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: ‘Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for.’ (Isaiah 6:6-7)

I immediately went to Scriptures and began to inquire of the Lord. What was this and what was it for!? Why now!? The Holy Spirit took me to Isaiah 6 where the prophet came to the mercy seat of God and encountered His presence. Feeling totally unqualified to be a spokesman for the Lord, Isaiah was undone in the midst of God’s glory. But it was there at the Throne of God that the seraphim, “the burning one,” came with a coal of fire and placed it on Isaiah’s lips. Upon receiving this fire from the altar, the

prophet was totally transformed. No longer hanging his head in shame, he quickly responded to the Lord’s invitation and said, “Here I am. Send me!” The fire of God had burned up his fleshly weakness and fear, and radically emboldened him with a zeal of the Lord to fulfill his call.

Upon learning more of this baptism of fire, I was both humbled and in awe. After all that I had gone through, to experience this was beyond anything I could have imagined. In the midst of the worst pain and struggle of my life, here I was experiencing these other-worldly realities that showcased God’s love, power, and supernatural presence. My attempts at “getting my healing” were now being overshadowed and overwhelmed by getting to know Him. He was going far beyond just healing my body. He was transforming me – mind, will, and emotions – from the inside out. He was inviting me even deeper into a work of the Spirit that I had never known before.

I would experience this same “burning” for the next two nights. Each time, I was awakened to find my entire body on fire. I would simply yield to the presence of the Lord and listen. I knew I was getting a transfusion, and I desperately needed it. I didn’t know where it would lead, but I was determined to let Him do His work. Whether it would eventually lead to full physical healing, or more valleys and tests, I didn’t know. But by this time, it didn’t matter. I was touching Him in ways I never felt worthy of. The heartaches, suffering, and unanswered questions from this journey were now very small compared to the glories I was experiencing.

*“For I consider that the sufferings of this present time are not worth comparing with the glory that is to be revealed to us.”
(Romans 8:18 ESV)*

As I sought the Lord concerning the many encounters in this journey, I was continually humbled. Even though I questioned His methods, His timing, and how He could “allow” some of the suffering I experienced, He was showing Himself to be a perfect Father. He loved me enough to challenge me and bring out the best in me (Hebrews 12:7-11). The apostle Paul exhorted believers to “share in the fellowship of His sufferings” (Philippians 3:10). Though Jesus never suffered due to physical illness, He was familiar with grief, disappointment, and pain. He demonstrated that

our earthly pain doesn't have to end in despair or defeat. When yielded to Him, it can become a tool that brings victory over the flesh and the devil, and a greater manifestation of His Kingdom power and authority.

There isn't any guarantee of a trouble-free life when surrendering to the Lord. There's only the absolute promise that He will be with us throughout the struggles and the setbacks. Some of the deepest revelations and most profound truths can only be found in the desert. But just as Jesus came out of His wilderness of testing with increased authority and anointing, so can we!

From Glory to Glory

In the months that followed, Bobby and I continued to yield to His direction and implement many of the things He was teaching us – both spiritually and practically. And though the fire of His presence gradually waned in subsequent months, it continues to simmer deep within my being. At the writing of this book, my tinnitus is virtually gone and we continue to see improvement in Bobby's eyes. We have continued to learn about the natural helps that are available for our physical well-being and are learning what it means to live in divine health instead of just looking for divine healing. What we thought we knew about healing has been radically altered. We believe God desires for us to be whole, not just healed.

*“Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely,
and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless
at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ. He who calls you is faithful;
He will surely do it.” (1 Thessalonians 5:23-24)*

What I learned throughout this journey has changed my life. The Lord took me through some valleys of despair in order to bring me to some mountaintops of glory. The revelations I received about His ways, His means, and His methods have forever changed me. Physical healing is one thing - spiritual health and vitality are another. And if I had to choose between the two, I'd rather have pain with the Glory instead of healing with no Presence. Yet, we don't have to choose! He offers us the full package of healing, restoration, AND glory – if we but yield to the process. How that looks will be different for everyone.

When people ask us to pray for their healing, we now look beyond just the presenting symptoms and ask for the wisdom of God in order to assess rightly. Many of the physical symptoms we experience are caused by something else. Medically speaking, the goal should always be to find the root cause and not just give medications to ease the visible symptoms. The same is true spiritually. Our bodies can often reflect that which is happening in our thoughts and emotions. Any toxic mindsets or unhealed areas of our soul can wreak havoc on our bodies. This is why we must make our sensitivity to His voice such a priority and seek His heart even more than a physical touch. He knows what actually needs healing first and will guide us through to complete restoration and wholeness.

*“May the God of endurance and encouragement grant you to live in such harmony with one another, in accord with Christ Jesus, that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.”
(Romans 15:5-6)*

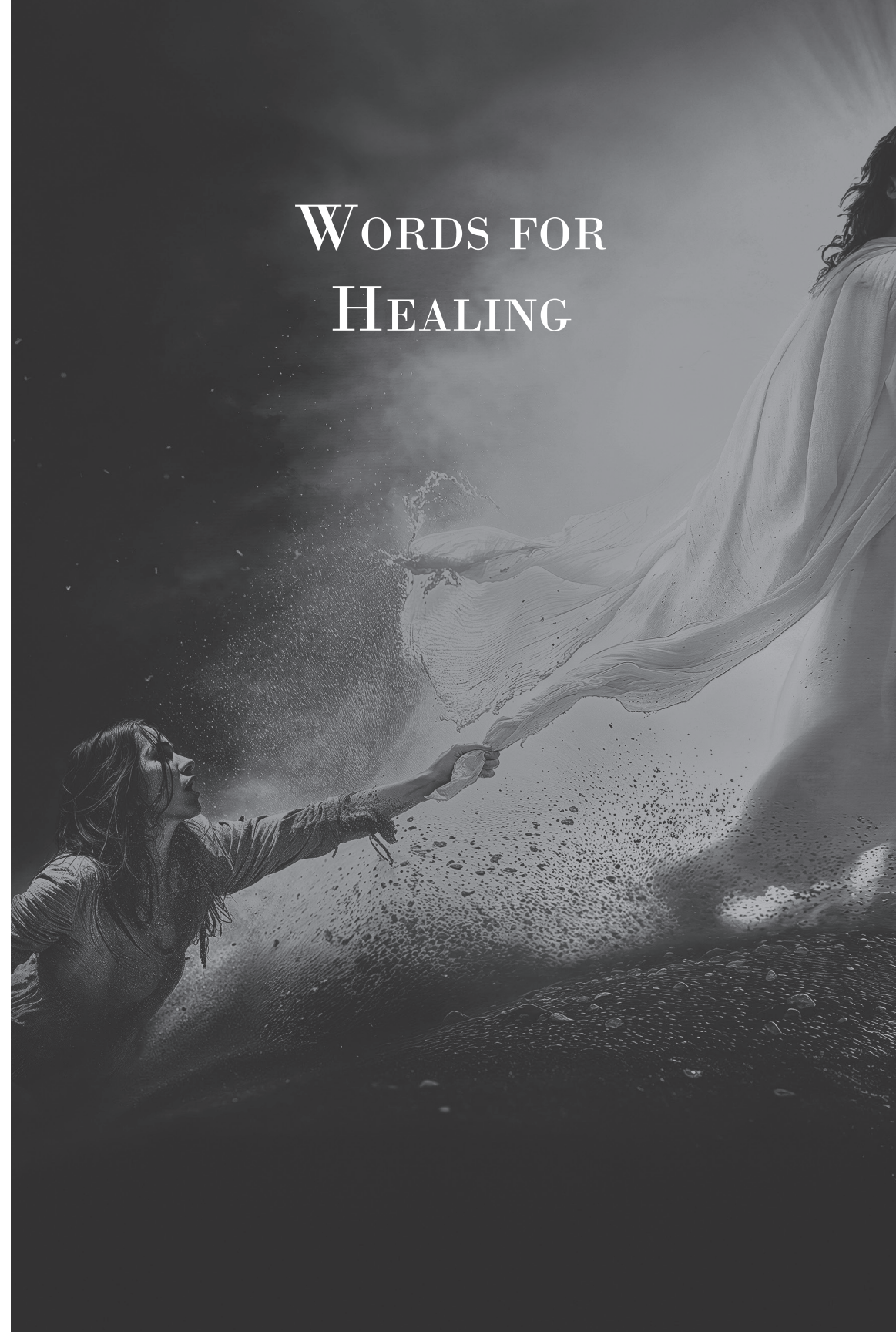
We also believe that faith is best activated when there is a complete alignment with the Father's heart, as well as with those we pray with. Just as Bobby and I saw the increased power and authority of our unified prayers, so believers must learn the power of our oneness of spirit to nullify and immobilize principalities and powers. As we agree from the heart, and not just our mouths, we will see the enemy's strongholds broken and healing will be released to the Body like never before. I believe there are regional spirits of infirmity in place that are greatly limiting our prayers for healing. It will take a corporate agreement to break these strongholds and see a flood of healing be released to the Body of Christ. (I write more about this at the end of the book.)

In sharing my own journey, I hope you are encouraged to see the beauty of the process. Obviously, what I experienced is unique to me. I'm certainly not suggesting that everything I experienced will happen to anyone else who follows a similar path. Your journey is specially tailored for you. God knows what He's already put inside of you, and He wants you to discover the power of the resurrected Christ within! Regardless of the challenges you face, He will walk with you every step of the way and teach you what to do, and how to do it. Do not let any suffering or pain deter you. Physical

symptoms do not determine the outcome! They are only temporary side effects of our fallen state. His grace is greater, and He will use it all for your good and His glory. Just don't quit, and don't stop believing. Your pursuit of Him will bring a reward far greater than you ever imagined and will be totally worth the cost of the journey.

Numbers 23:19
