PRAYERS FOR UNITY AMONG LEADERS

(Excerpts from WORDS TO PRAY BY)

Acts 2:42-43

They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles.

As I pray for my church, Lord, I ask to keep us faithful to sound doctrine that secures our spiritual foundations. I pray that our fellowship would be heart-felt and deep. I pray that we would continually celebrate the power of the cross and consistently lift our prayers and intercessions before You in unity. May we be a body that is a conduit of miracles for Your glory that would draw in the lost and the hurting.

Romans 12:16

Live in harmony with one another. Do not be proud but be willing to associate with people of low position. Do not be conceited.

Father, cleanse the Church of selysh ambition and pride. Help us to see where we think less of others and more of ourselves. Give us Your heart towards those who are ill-treated by the world and shunned by society. Show us how to love them well and demonstrate Your kindness towards them.

1 Corinthians 12:20-23a

As it is, there are many parts, but one body. The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!" And the head cannot say to the feet, "I don't need you!" On the contrary, those parts of the body that seem to be weaker are indispensable, and the parts that we think are less honorable we treat with special honor.

Thank You, Lord, for using every part of the Church in a unique and special way. Forgive me for comparing or complaining about those in the Church that I don't understand. Help me see the value of each brother and sister and the unique role they play in the work of Your Kingdom.

1 Corinthians 12:25-26

2 Corinthians 13:11

Ephesians 4:3-6

Ephesians 4:13

Ephesians 5:29-30

Acts 2:1-4

Romans 12:4-8

For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully.

Open my eyes, Lord, to see the unique gifts of each of my brothers and sisters. Rather than comparing ourselves with each other, may we see our unique contributions as gifts from You. May we recognize the grace on one another's life and champion one another's call. Help us celebrate our diⁿ erences as pieces of a larger picture. Romans 12:16

1 Corinthians 12:18-20
