

## **A Biblical Overview of spiritual beings, heavenly realms, and celestial entities**

*If the Church is going to be adequately prepared for what is “disclosed” and revealed in the days to come concerning other-worldly realities, we must know what Scripture already tells us. In knowing God’s Word, believers will be able to walk in absolute authority over every principality and power that has sought to counterfeit what God has created for their own wicked purposes. See what Scriptures reveal concerning the realms we cannot see with our natural eyes so that we can walk in faith and not fear.*

### **A Brief Listing of Various Supernatural Realities Mentioned in Scripture:**

#### **1. The Divine Council and Heavenly Assembly**

The Bible depicts a heavenly council of spiritual beings, including Sons of God, divine gods, and heavenly hosts, who stand before God and participate in divine governance.

- Job 1:6 and Job 2:1 describe the **Sons of God** presenting themselves before the Lord, with Satan among them.
- Job 38:7 mentions all the sons of God shouting for joy at creation.
- Psalm 29:1 and Psalm 82:1 highlight **heavenly beings** and **divine council members**.
- Psalm 82:6 and Psalm 89:5–7 refer to **gods** and holy ones, emphasizing divine authority.
- Daniel 4:13, 17, and 23 mention **watchers** and **holy ones** descending from heaven.

#### **2. Angelic Beings and Their Roles**

Angels are depicted as messengers, protectors, warriors, and agents of divine judgment, actively involved in biblical narratives.

- Genesis 16:7–11 and Genesis 19:1 introduce angels as messengers and visitors.
- Genesis 22:11–15 and Genesis 24:7 show angels **calling** and **guiding**.
- Exodus 3:2 and Exodus 14:19 describe angels **appearing in flames and leading** Israel.
- Daniel 6:22 and other passages show **angels shutting lions’ mouths** and delivering God's servants.
- The New Testament depicts angels **ministering** to Jesus (Matthew 4:11), **proclaiming** at resurrection (Matthew 28:2–7), and guarding believers (Psalm 91:11–12).
- Revelation describes angels as worshippers, warriors, and proclaimers, with **specific roles in end-times events**.

#### **3. Cherubim and Their Guardianship Role**

Cherubim are heavenly throne guardians associated with Eden, the tabernacle, and God's throne.

- Genesis 3:24 shows cherubim **guarding** Eden.
- Exodus 25:18–22 and 26:1 describe cherubim **on the mercy seat** and woven into the tabernacle.

- Ezekiel 1 and 10 detail cherubim as **living creatures with wheels, associated with divine chariot-throne.**

#### **4. Seraphim as Fiery Heavenly Beings**

Seraphim are fiery beings seen by Isaiah around God's throne, characterized by six wings.

- Isaiah 6:1–7 describes seraphim **standing above the throne, praising God.**
- The **Hebrew term "seraph" also relates to fiery serpents**, with references in Numbers and Isaiah indicating fiery or flying serpents.

#### **5. Living Creatures Around the Throne**

These are angelic or divine beings with multiple faces and wings, worshipping God.

- Ezekiel 1 and Revelation 4–5 describe four **living creatures with four faces and wings, full of eyes.**
- Revelation depicts them worshipping and calling out to God, involved in end-time events.

#### **6. Satan, the Devil, and the Serpent (Halel)**

Satan is depicted as a **rebellious angel, serpent, and dragon**, with references to his fall, accusations, and role as **deceiver**.

- Genesis 3:1–15 introduces the serpent.
- Job 1–2 and Zechariah 3:1–2 depict Satan among divine beings and **accusing**.
- Matthew 4:1–11 and Luke 10:18 describe Satan's temptations and fall.
- Revelation 12 and 20 identify Satan as the great red dragon, serpent, and **adversary**, ultimately judged and cast into the lake of fire.

#### **7. Demons, Unclean Spirits, and Evil Entities**

Demons are unclean spirits and evil spirits that oppress, possess, and deceive humans.

- Leviticus and Deuteronomy mention spirits and **demons associated with pagan sacrifices.**
- The Gospels describe Jesus casting out demons (Matthew 8:16, Mark 5:1–20).
- Demonic spirits are identified as **spirits of divination, lying spirits, and unclean spirits, with some named spirits like Legion.**

#### **8. Hierarchies of Spiritual Powers and Authorities**

Scripture describes **ranks of spiritual powers, including principalities, rulers, thrones, dominions, and authorities.**

- Daniel 10:13 and 12:1 mention **princes of Persia and Michael as a chief prince.**
- Ephesians 1:20–21 and Colossians 1:16 describe Christ's authority over **all rule and powers.**
- Ephesians 6:12 and Colossians 2:10 highlight spiritual forces of evil and disarmed rulers.
- These ranks indicate a structured spiritual hierarchy operating behind earthly kingdoms.

## 9. Giants, Nephilim, and Ancient Clans

Biblical references to giants and giant clans, including Nephilim, Anakim, Rephaim, and Og.

- Genesis 6:1–4 introduces the Nephilim as on the earth in ancient days.
- Numbers 13 and Deuteronomy mention descendants of Anak and Rephaim.
- Joshua and 2 Samuel describe the conquest of **giants** like Og of Bashan.
- These beings were **tall, formidable, and associated with ancient giant clans.**

## 10. Sea Monsters, Leviathan, and Chaos Creatures

Mythic creatures like Leviathan, Behemoth, and sea monsters **symbolize chaos and divine power.**

- Job 3:8 and 41 describe **Leviathan as a mighty sea creature.**
- Psalm 74:13–14 and Isaiah 27:1 mention Leviathan and Rahab as chaos monsters.
- Ezekiel 29 and Revelation 12 depict **dragons and sea monsters** symbolizing chaos and evil.

## 11. Apollyon, Locust creatures from the Abyss

APOLLYON / ABADDON named destroyer being.

- Revelation 9:11 - "And they had a king over them, which is **the angel of the bottomless pit**, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon."
- Revelation 9:7–10 - "And the **shapes of the locusts were like unto horses** prepared unto battle...and they had **faces of men**, And they had hair as **the hair of women**, and their **teeth were as the teeth of lions**. And they **had breastplates...** and **tails like unto scorpions...**"

## 12. Strange Wilderness Beings and Mythical Creatures

Includes **satyrs, goat demons, wild animals, and strange beings in wilderness contexts.**

- Leviticus 17:7 and 2 Chronicles 11:15 mention goat demons and idols.
- Isaiah 13:21 and 34:14 describe wild goats and night creatures.
- These beings are associated with wilderness and pagan practices. **Different forms.**

## DIFFERENT REALMS MENTIONED...

### 1. Heaven and Heavens

Descriptions of heaven, including the highest heavens, third heaven, and open heavens.

- Genesis 1:1 and Deuteronomy 10:14 describe the **creation of the heavens.**
- 2 Corinthians 12:2–4 mentions the **third heaven and paradise.**
- Revelation 4 and 21 depict visions of heaven, **the throne room, and new creation.**
- The heavens are portrayed as **the dwelling place of God, angels, and future divine activity.**

## 2. Heavenly Temples, Thrones, and Divine Thrones

The biblical depiction of divine thrones, heavenly temples, and sanctuaries.

- Exodus 25:9, 40 and 1 Kings 22:19 describe **the heavenly pattern and throne**.
- Isaiah 6:1–4 and Ezekiel 1 depict divine throne visions.
- Revelation 4–5 shows the throne in heaven with divine worship.
- These structures **symbolize divine authority and divine presence**.

## 3. Realm of the Abyss, Sheol, and Underworld

References to Sheol, the bottomless pit, and realms of the dead.

- Numbers 16:30–33 and Job 26:6 describe Sheol and **the abyss**.
- Revelation 9 and 20 depict the **bottomless pit** and its angelic keeper.
- Psalm 139:8 and Proverbs 15:11 mention **Sheol as a realm of the dead**.
- These realms are **associated with judgment, chaos, and spiritual imprisonment**.

## OTHER OBJECTS IN THE HEAVENS

### 1. Sun, Moon, and Lights in the Heavens

The Bible describes celestial bodies such as the sun, moon, stars, and constellations as God's creations that declare His glory and are involved in worship and divine signs.

- Genesis 1:14–18 mentions the **sun, moon, and stars as lights in the sky**.
- The **sun and moon are involved in events like standing still** (Joshua 10:12–13) and darkening (Isaiah 13:10).
- The **heavens declare God's glory** (Psalm 19:1).
- The **host of heaven is worshiped** and considered part of God's ordered creation.
- The **celestial bodies are involved in apocalyptic events, such as the full moon turning blood** (Revelation 6:12–13).

### 2. Stars, Wandering Stars, and Celestial Symbols

Stars serve as symbols of divine messengers, fallen angels, and messianic figures, with references to the morning star and wandering stars.

- Numbers 24:17 predicts a star coming from Jacob.
- Job 38:7 and 12 describe **stars singing and casting down**.
- **The morning star is associated with fallen angels** (Isaiah 14:12) and Christ (Revelation 22:16).
- **Wandering stars** (Jude 13) symbolize false teachers; the Greek term relates to the concept of planets as "wandering stars."
- Stars are also used in visions and symbolism, such as the **seven stars representing angels of churches (Revelation 1:16, 20)**.

### 3. Celestial Objects, flying Horses, Airborne Phenomena

Objects like flying scrolls, ephah, angels, and eagles symbolize divine messages and judgment.

- Zechariah describes a **flying scroll and ephah (bushel)** lifted between earth and heaven.
- Revelation depicts **angels and eagles flying overhead**, symbolizing divine activity.
- Zechariah describes **mounted patrols on horses** of various colors (Zechariah 1:8–11; 6:1–8).
- Revelation depicts Christ and **armies on white horses** (Revelation 6:2; 19:11–14).

#### 4. Constellations and Celestial Groupings

Biblical references mention constellations like Pleiades, Orion, and the Bear, emphasizing God's creation and control over these groupings.

- Job 9:9 and 38:31–32 mention the **Bear, Orion, and Pleiades**.
- Job 38:32 references the **Mazzaroth**, a term possibly denoting the zodiac or celestial cycles.

#### 5. The Universe and Invisible Creation

Scripture depicts a vast cosmos including heavens, earth, and invisible realms, emphasizing God's sovereignty over all creation.

- Colossians 1:16 mentions **both visible and invisible creations**.
- The universe is described as created by God's word (Hebrews 11:3) and includes a third heaven (2 Corinthians 12:2).
- **The new heaven and new earth** are part of God's ultimate plan (Revelation 21:1).

### HEAVENLY MODES OF TRANSPORT

The Bible describes divine movement through chariots of fire, clouds, whirlwinds, and Spirit-led transport.

- Elijah was taken to heaven by a **whirlwind** (2 Kings 2:1, 11).
- God's **chariots are described as fiery and whirlwind-like** (Psalm 68:17, Isaiah 66:15).
- God **rides on clouds and cherubim**, often depicted as swift and majestic (Psalm 104:3, Daniel 7:13).
- The Son of Man is seen coming on clouds (Matthew 24:30).
- Ezekiel's **throne-chariot features wheels**, living creatures, and Spirit-driven movement (Ezekiel 1, 10).
  
- Elijah and Ezekiel are **carried by the Spirit** (2 Kings 2; Ezekiel 3, 8, 11).
- Philip was **transported by the Spirit** (Acts 8:39–40).
- Believers are **caught up to the third heaven** (2 Corinthians 12:2).

## **ARE THERE OTHER PLANETS?**

Ancient observers did not categorize planets separately the way modern astronomy does. To the naked eye planets appeared star-like, but moved differently (“wandering stars”). The ancients often grouped all visible heavenly lights together.

*“Raging waves of the sea, foaming out their own shame; wandering stars, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever.” (Jude 1:13)*

**Greek: “planētai asteres”** This literally means: “wandering or erratic teachers” This is extremely significant because the Greek root “planētai” is where we get the English word “planet.” In the ancient world, planets were called “wandering stars” because they moved differently from fixed constellations.

*By faith we understand that the universe was created by the word of God, so that what is seen was not made out of things that are visible. (Hebrews 11:3)*

*The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims His handiwork. Day to day pours out speech, and night to night reveals knowledge. There is no speech, nor are there words, whose voice is not heard. Their voice goes out through all the earth, and their words to the end of the world. (Psalms 19:1-4)*

*“And when you hear of wars and tumults, do not be terrified, for these things must first take place, but the end will not be at once.” Then He said to them, “Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. There will be great earthquakes, and in various places famines and pestilences. And there will be terrors and great signs from heaven.” (Luke 21:9-11)*

The Greek word for “terrors” is “phobetron” which, when translated according to the Greeks, meant “monster.” This suggests not only fearful “things” but actually living “beings” that will cause fear and terror. Could this be what the enemy will try to do in the last days through counterfeit demonic manifestations?

Even if this is true, we NEED NOT FEAR...

1. The Bible clearly reveals the EXPANSE of God’s UNIVERSE (Spiritual Realms).
2. Satan counterfeits EVERYTHING that God has made in order to STEAL, KILL, and DESTROY. (Thus, we shouldn’t be surprised when similar “beings” or “objects” appear in the sky!)
3. There is NO FEAR warranted because whatever is “disclosed” will only PROVE THE GREATNESS OF OUR GOD.

## **SCRIPTURAL CASE FOR ONLY ONE PLANET – AND ONE SAVIOR...**

### **God created....**

Genesis 1:1

*In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.*

Genesis 1:27 (He created MAN in HIS IMAGE – we reflect Him)

*So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.*

### **All of His creation worships HIM**

Nehemiah 9:6

*You are the Lord, you alone. You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host, the earth and all that is on it, the seas and all that is in them; and You preserve all of them; and the host of heaven worships You.*

### **God gave His only Son to free us from sin and death.**

John 3:16

*For God so loved the world, that He gave His only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life.*

John 1:14

*And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.*

**He was the one and only Son of Creator God.**

**He is also the exact representation of God.**

Colossians 1:15

*He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation.*

### **In order to redeem mankind, He had to become LIKE US - human.**

Hebrews 2:17

*Therefore He had to be made like His brothers in every respect, so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest in the service of God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.*

1 Timothy 2:5

*For there is one God, and there is one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus.*

**If the death and resurrection of Jesus is core to our faith, He would also need to be born on other planets and go through the same process of death and resurrection. BUT - Jesus died one time for all mankind!**

Hebrews 10:12

*But when Christ had offered for all time a single sacrifice for sins, He sat down at the right hand of God.*

1 Peter 3:18

*For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, that He might bring us to God, being put to death in the flesh but made alive in the spirit,*

Revelation 1:17-18

*When I saw Him (Jesus), I fell at His feet as though dead. But He laid his right hand on me, saying, "Fear not, I am the first and the last, and the living one. I died, and behold I am alive forevermore, and I have the keys of Death and Hades.*

**Jesus came, as a human man, to die once for all.**

**There are no other planets or "aliens"**

**Any sign of other life is either fake or a dark spiritual force trying to deceive.**

Why would the enemies of God promote this narrative? To dismisses WHO JESUS IS! They may speak of "GOD" – but not JESUS in regards to His death and resurrection and eternal life with Him. "God consciousness" is not the same!
